Our finger plays today

"Did You Ever See a Penguin?"

Did you ever see a penguin, a penguin, a penguin?

Did you ever see a penguin waddle this way and that?(Waddle all different ways!)

Waddle this way and that way, waddle this way and that way

Did you ever see a penguin waddle this way and that?

Fingerplay: "Two Little Penguins"

Two little penguins sitting on the ice (hold up two fingers)

One bows once, the other bows twice (made index fingers bow)

Waddle little penguins. Waddle away. (put fingers behind back)

Come back penguins. Time to play! (bring fingers to the front)

Our craft is your very own penguin puppet! You will need a glue stick or tape to complete this project.

Materials -black oval -2 black triangles -orange heart for feet
 -orange triangle nose -spoon -googley eyes

Glue the pointed part of the heart to the bottom of the circle near the slit. These are your penguin's feet. Glue the black triangles/wings to the long sides of your oval. Slip the spoon into the slit, and glue the eyes and attach the nose above the top of the spoon. Now you can play with your penguin puppet!
