Our finger play today

The Owl

There's a wide-eyed owl (thumb and forefingers around eyes)

With a pointed nose, (point to nose)

Two pointed ears, (point to ears)

And claws for toes. (fingers bent into claws)

He sits high up in the tree, And he looks at me and he looks at you, (point at a child in the group)

He flaps his wings, (crook elbows and flap arms)

And he says "Whoop, Whoop."



Our craft today is an owl! You will need a glue stick to complete this project.

Materials	-paper hand shape	-2 feathers	-2 circle eyes
	-1 orange nose	-2 triangle ears	

Glue the feathers onto the thumb and pinky fingers of your hand. Glue on the eyes and draw in the pupils. Fold the orange beak in half and glue under the eyes. Glue the ears on the back of the hand. Now practice your hoots!
