Our finger play today

The Turkey Pokey Tune: Hokey Pokey

You put your right wing in
you put your right wing out
You put your right wing in
And you shake it all about.

You do the turkey pokey
And you turn yourself around.
That's what it's all about.

Additional verses:

Left wing, Drumsticks (legs), Stuffing (tummy), Wattle (head), Turkey body (whole self)



Our craft today is a turkey hat! You will need a glue stick to complete this project.

Materials -brown turkey head shape -2 google eyes -yellow
triangle nose -colorful feathers -two orange legs -2
brown strips

Glue the eyes, beak and red wattle to the front of your turkey shape. Turn your turkey over and glue the feathers to the bottom of the back of your turkey. Glue your orange turkey legs to the bottom part of the turkey. Use the two brown strips to make a circle that will fit your head. Glue your turkey to the front of your circle. Wear your turkey!
