Our finger play today

Snowflakes, snowflakes, falling down (wiggle fingers in the air)

Can you catch them on your nose? (wiggle fingers to your nose)  
Will they fall and touch your toes? (wiggle fingers to touch toes)  
Snowflakes, snowflakes, falling down (wiggle fingers in the air)  
Falling, falling to the ground (wiggle fingers to the ground)

Our craft is a sparkly snowflake! You will need a glue stick or tape to complete this project

Materials    -white snowflake shape cutout                      -piece of laminate  
                    -small container of glitter                      -small snowflakes and snowmen

*Pull the backing off of the laminate paper and attach it to the brown part of your snowflake, making sure you cover the snowflake. Place the snowflake on a flat surface sticky side up. Sprinkle the glitter over the entire snowflake, and then shake the excess off into the garbage. Glue the small decorations to the front.*
